## Presentation of Dr. Shuddhananda Bharati

11th May 1897 - 7th March 1990

#### The wise one to the cosmic age

Although more than 90 years old, in his beautiful school in the south of India, *Kavi Yogi Maharishi* (great divine visionary, wise poet), Dr. Shuddhananda Bharati worked like a young man of twenty. When he was asked his age, he answered: "My age is Courage!"

The Yogi wrote several hundred works in English, French, Tamil, Hindi, Telugu and Sanskrit; five thousand songs, and fifteen hundred poems in French. The magnum opus of the man conscious of the presence of God in him, *Bharata Shakti*, (in 50,000 verses) described his ideal: only One Humanity living in communion with only One God in a transformed world! *Bharata Shakti* is a monumental and unique work. The Yogi depicts the gasoline of all the religions, of all the prophets and saints, all the approaches of Yoga and all the cultures on

an allegorical fabric. It is a book for any age which all spiritual researchers and all nations should read and meditate on.

His commitment is summarized in his book celebrating his life, *L'Ame Pèlerine* (*Pilgrim Soul*).

The three poems mentioned in the opening express perfectly his ideal.

His mantra, *Aum Shuddha Shakti Aum*, nourishes our souls and guides our steps toward the inner joy *Ananda*. It means: The light of Grace and power of the pure supreme Almighty bless us with peace, happiness and prosperity!

That beauty, joyful and greatness of soul of Kavi Yogi Dr. Shuddhananda Bharati bloom and scent the entire earth with its divine message and his spiritual and unifying benefactor!

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#### Path of universal Love

#### 1. Love everywhere

Darkness withdrew on sighting the joyous face of dawn; dreams were dispelled; eyes woke up; flowers bloomed; birds chirped; devotees sang. The world appears to be a temple of peace. We shall look to the east and meditate; then love shall flower in the heart. The whole world appears to be filled with love; that love has blossomed in peace. The nature all around us shows the path of universal love.

"Love, love" blows the gentle breeze. "Love, love" smile the bashful flowers; they provide a feast of fragrance to the breeze and a feast of honey to the bees; "Love, love" sing and fly the awakened birds, flapping their wings; "Love, love" sway the tender plants in the gentle breeze.

"Love, love" flows the waterway; "Love, love" irrigates the gardener's bucket. Krishna's music from the flute says "Love, love"; a child's prattle that is sweeter than

the flute's music lisps "Love, love;" the mother's heart beats to "Love, love" as she embraces and kisses the child. Lovers' eyes are filled with love. The loving heart of a devotee cries out for the love of God; the music of love plays in the temples. "Ply your trade" encourages love; the world becomes a factory. Love drives and sustains domestic life. The earth's ethics are sustained, and justice flourishes due to mankind's love; God's love sustains divine ethics; it dispels ignorance.

The sounds of speech, music and activity—the whole world is full of sound. There rises the sun to oversee this sound-filled world; he blesses the world with his rays of love. He is welcomed eagerly by the world. Evening prayers are conducted for his sake. The lotus bud that is closed in the darkness unfurls its petals and welcomes him with a smile. He progresses in the blue sky as a silent witness. He blesses the plants and the living beings during his progression; he transforms the world naturally into a sculpture. The summer heat is unbearable; there, the garden's shade

beckons us. The breeze of love is blowing there: the trees offer the fruits of love. How can one describe the compassion of these trees that do not partake of their own fruits but instead offer them to the world! Dry summer; the plants look to the sky. "I have come" the sky mother showers her love. The dark clouds gather in a heap. The rain of love flows down; the plants flourish. The sky's love nurtures the world. In the evening, he disappears in a blaze of loving golden smiles. Thereafter a thousand scenes of love are witnessed. Look at the hearts of the evening jasmine! A loving smile emits its fragrance; the sky is enveloped in darkness; so much magic unfurls in that darkness! Millions and millions of flowers of love bloom in the sky. "Look, love, love" they twinkle and beckon us! Lightning flashes with loving smiles. "Do not be afraid: I am here" a loving father gives us courage.

The moon glides along like a silver swan; it sheds loving moonlight. Water lilies rejoice. "Oh, my love," the sea surges in a frenzy of love! Our loving hearts merge

with the silver moon and rejoice. How many loving sights surround and play around us! The sky, fish, sun, moon, fire, wind, sea, mountain, spring, paddy field, forest, plants, life are all actors in this limitless drama of love; let us fulfil our roles with love for the sake of love; this love one witnesses in nature is life, the way of life and the secret of life; this love is the heart of the *Vedas*; this love alone is the way to attain God.

#### 2. Love is the Vedas

Manikkavachakar became Siva Himself out of love; Siva is the embodiment of love; Manikkavachakar said, "My joy, my great love!" My great love – joy – is but Siva. All other joys pale in comparison; God alone is supreme joy; that joy is a flood of love; only with an abundance of love can one attain the joyous God. Manikkavachakar gave himself to Siva; the fire of Siva consumed him like camphor touched by flame; a flood of Siva's joy inundated his heart; title, position, property, pleasures,

respect, disrespect, arrogance of I and mine – that flood consumed everything and roared 'Siva, Siva'. His relatives called him mad. The king imprisoned him, hated him, ridiculed him, beat him with a stick. Manikkavachakar tolerated everything saying, "Siva, I have dedicated my body, mind and soul only to You; good and bad, everything is Your doing." He had no fear of a murderous sword or death. But he feared a few people. Who?...

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
